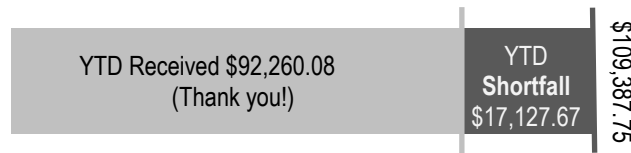

Brunswick Church Operating Budget



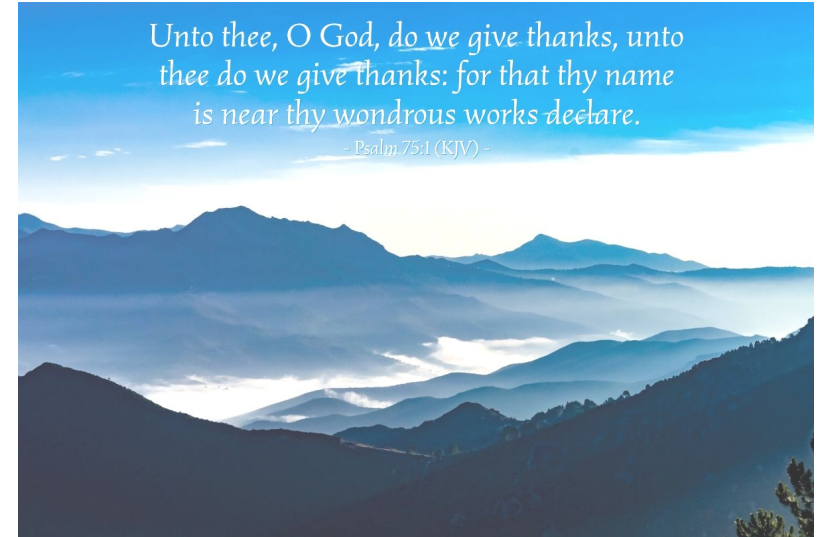
Elevator Fund Received: \$4,450.00

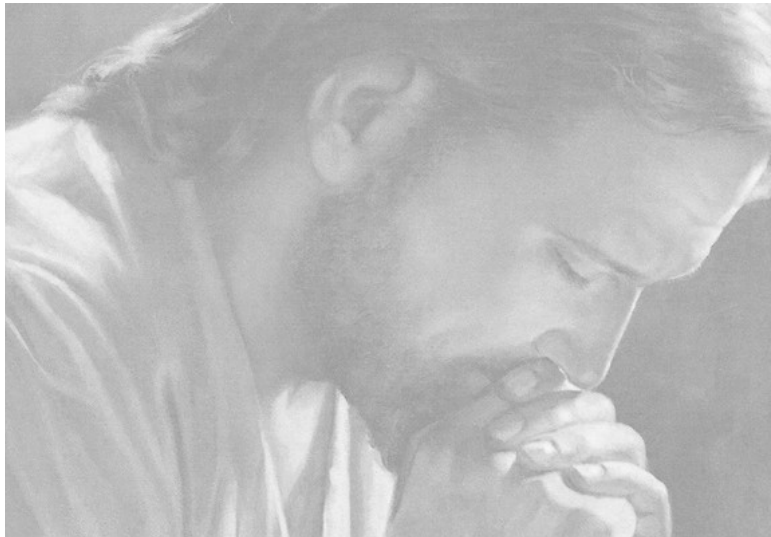
He had taken humanity, and He bore our infirmities and became sin for us. Christ retired to the groves or mountains with the world and everything else shut out.
