Completing your financial aid request early is important. There are local and conference Worthy Student financial aid funds available, but they are allocated early in the school year.

Things to be taken into consideration for financial aid qualifications are:

- Income
- Number of children in the school
- Number of children attending other private schools
- Other factors pertaining to household finances

To apply:

- Complete the Financial Aid Request Form
- Copy the first page of your last year's Federal Tax form(s) i.e., 1040, 1040A, etc.
- Copies of supporting documentation for figures entered on Financial Aid Request Form
- Copy of tuition amounts for private schooling, if applicable
- Documentation for any extraordinary items that may affect financial need
- Submit your request to the Treasurer/Bookkeeper or Board Chairperson as soon as possible

The Finance Committee will meet and review your request. You will be notified if your student(s) is eligible for aid and the amount that will be awarded.
