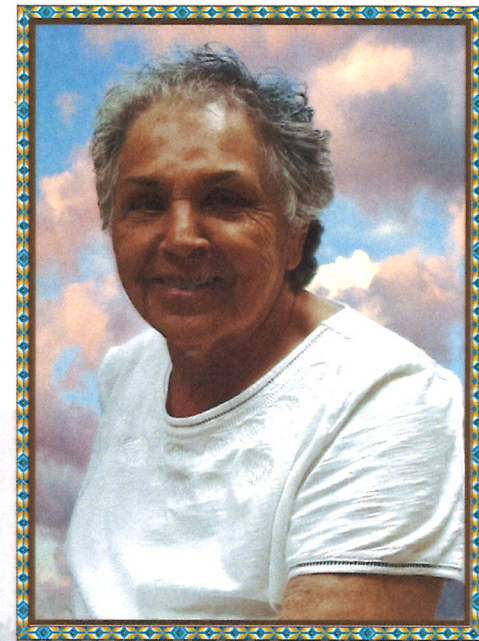


Never Forget You
