You will find me there*

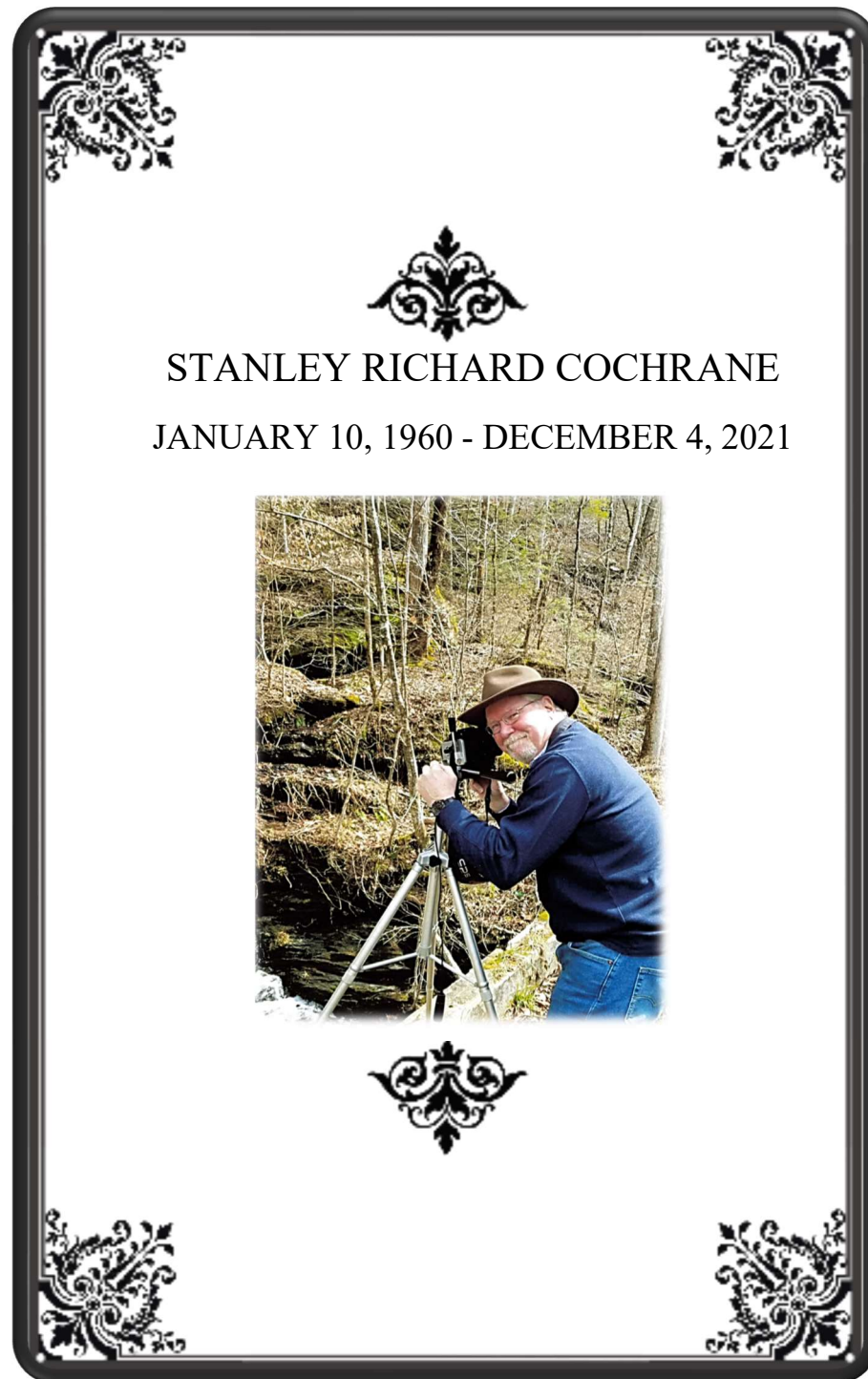
*Feel every heartbeat
