On September 14, 2000, God decided to bless the world with a manifestation of love, life, and laughter, thus Quintavious Michael Drovon Young was born.

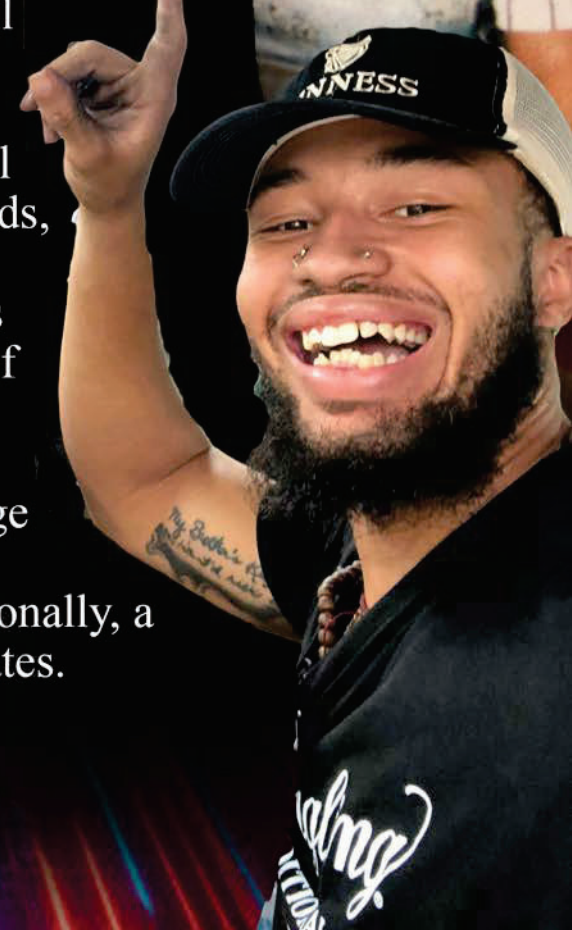

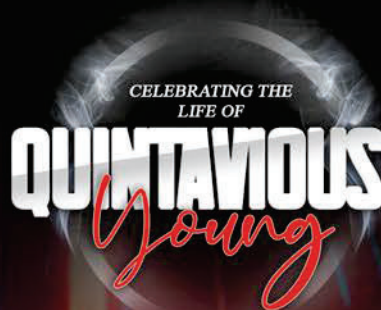
