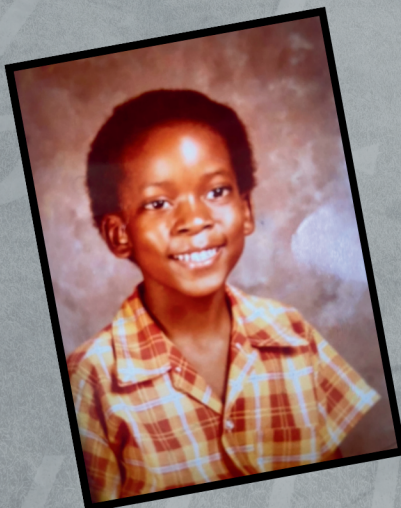
Donta Levite Jacobs
