**Mabel Elizabeth Gyberg** was born to Christian and Alma (Reichelt) Larson on February 3, 1924 in Montrose, South Dakota. She moved with her family first to Colton and later to Dell Rapids, South Dakota. She attended country school through the eighth grade and attended two years at Dell Rapids High School. While still in Dell Rapids, Mabel waitressed at a local café and cared for and did the housekeeping for a family with three children. On April 4, 1943 she married Knute Gyberg at her mother's home in Dell Rapids. The couple made their first home on a farm near Magnolia, Minnesota until 1947 when they moved to a farm near Beaver Creek, Minnesota. In 1949 they moved and began farming by Luverne, Minnesota and it was there they raised their four sons. Knute preceded her in death on January 28, 1990. Mabel moved to Luverne and lived there for 17 years before she moved to Bethany Meadows in Brandon, South Dakota in April of 2007. On Sunday, February 19, 2023 Mabel went to be with her Lord at the age of 99 years and 16 days.

Mabel was a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Luverne and the Lydia Circle. She had been most recently attending Chapel at Bethany Meadows. Time spent with family was dear to Mabel and she enjoyed traveling, reading, fishing, playing cards (especially pinochle), completing word searches and putting puzzles together.

She will be lovingly remembered by her son, Norman and his wife Darlene of Magnolia, Minnesota; two daughters-in-law, Irene Gyberg of Brandon, and Kathy Gyberg of Luverne; grandchildren; and numerous great-grandchildren. Mabel was preceded in death by her husband, Knute; three sons, Steven, Dennis and Stanley; her parents; three brothers; and four sisters.
