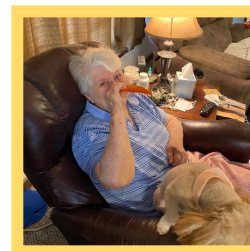
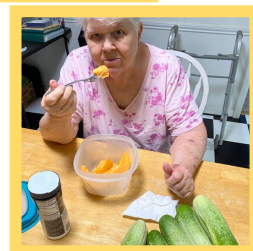
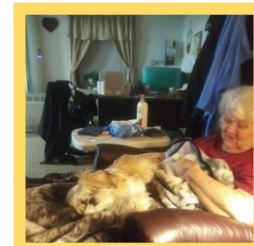
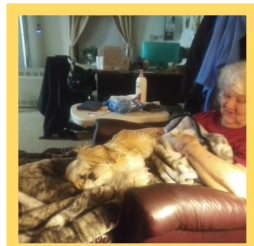
## Reflections
