The three key tournaments the team participate in are the Australian Junior Open held in April, the Squash NSW Junior State Titles in July, and the Australian Junior Championships held in Sept/Oct. It is imperative that the candidate is available to attend these key events.

Junior State Squad Camps are also held to develop junior talent and provide expert coaching within regional towns and cities and the Sydney metro area. The assistant coach will be required to assist the NSW Junior State Coach with Squad Camps where required.
