Our Pastor Needs Your Prayers

October is Pastor Appreciation month! Our pastor needs many kinds of prayers, especially these:

1. Pray for his humility and wisdom.

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. (James 1:5)
