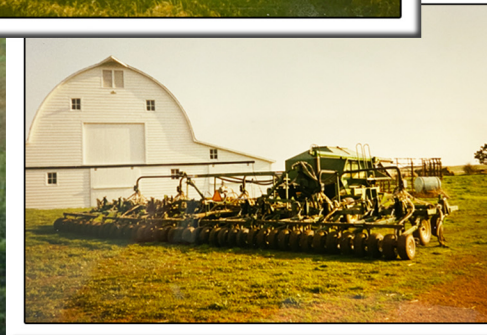

As an excellent welder, he utilized his welding skills to help construct the towers for the lights placed at the Hebron High School football field.
