Two different articles to work the decoupage on (*Recommend wooden plaque, wooden cutting board, clear glass plate or wooden box. Make sure the article is large enough for the picture you want to use*)

Pictures or photos printed on paper

Mod Podge (you can substitute school glue in a pinch)

Brushes or sponges

Roller or dowel (brayer)

Scissors

Clean-up rags

Mod Podge Photo Transfer Medium

Sand paper or steel wool
