
**Departure Details:**

**Special Note about Carry-On Luggage:**



Packing will be a challenge. There are online tutorials that might help you learn to pack light. Your child is only allowed one carry-on and one personal item. If you pack too much, you will need to pay out of your

pocket to check your bags. The cost would be around \$30 for your first checked bag and \$40 for a second, each way. Don't forget you will need to figure out how to fit your sleeping bag along with your carry-on. One suggestion is to use compression bags. To help save space, students should consider either taking pictures or making photo copies of the necessary textbooks that will be needed for studying.
