Robert Jenkins Kirtley, 91, of Bowling Green died at 5:26 a.m., Monday, June 20, 2011 at Greenview Regional Hospital.

The Bowling Green native owned and operated a successful furniture store for many years. He attended Bowling Green Business University, then he was drafted and honorably served his country for four years in the Army during the European campaign in World War II. He volunteered for an unnamed mission which turned out to be a military intelligence unit attached to the 101st Airborne Unit. When he was discharged from the Army he returned to Bowling Green and joined his brother in the furniture business. He enjoyed fishing, golf, gardening, and traveling the world with his wife of 65 years, Judy Cassidy Kirtley, who survives. He was a charter member of Eastwood Baptist Church and served as its treasurer for 22 years, taught Sunday School, was a deacon, served on many committees, and was named Deacon Emeritus in 2006. He was the son of the late Edwin Kirtley and Edna Jenkins Kirtley. He was preceded in death by a brother, Samuel H. Kirtley and a sister, Edwina Kirtley Dennis.
