She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church for many years, which was an important part of her life.

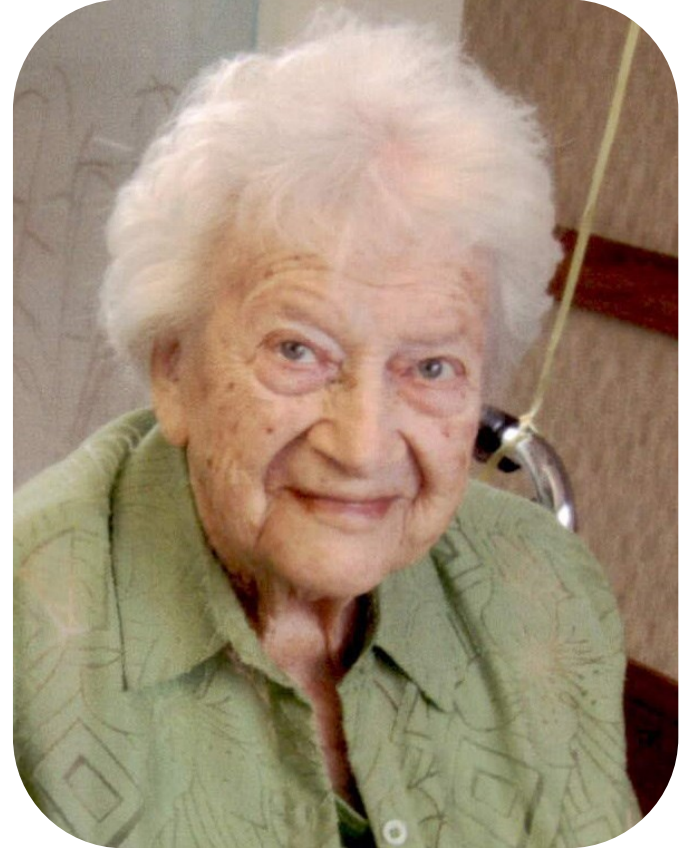
