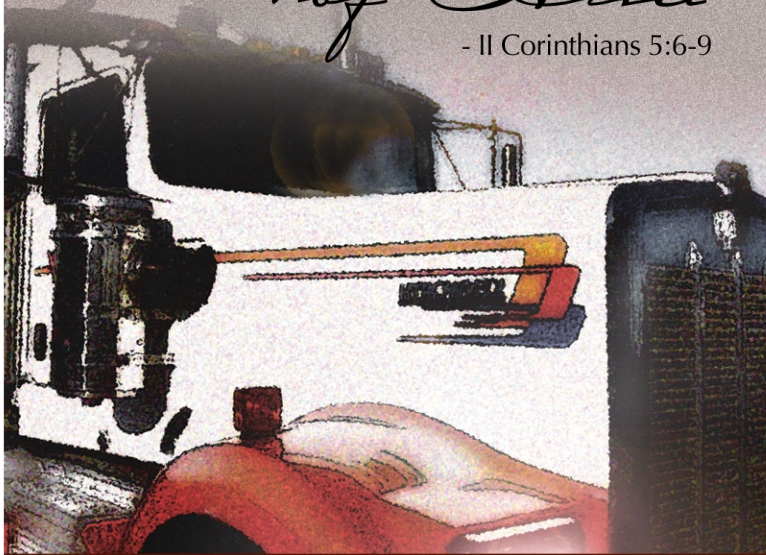


Therefore we are
