

GSAA Student Merit Scholarships



The GSAA Merit Scholarship is awarded to outstanding students who excel in academics, athletics, fine arts, or leadership. This scholarship rewards students' hard work and dedication, acknowledges their personal strengths, and assists with funding an Adventist education. The application process requires documentation that specific criteria has been met, a written essay, and letters of recommendation.

- **Areas of opportunity: Academics, Athletics, Fine Arts, and Leadership.**
- Only one scholarship is granted each year per area of opportunity listed above.
- Students may only apply for one area per year and receive the scholarship once per area. They must have attended GSAA for two years before applying.
- **All forms are due by September 15.**
- Yearly scholarship awards:
 - \$2,000 for dorm students
 - \$1,500 for day students
 - Paid out over two semesters - January (1st semester) and June (2nd semester)
 - Reflected on final semester bills
 - Contingent on continuing to meet the criteria
- Requirements:
 - Application Form completed and submitted by September 15
 - Provide three letters of recommendation (forms attached) in sealed envelopes from such sources as a teacher, pastor, coach, mentor (must be relevant to the area of opportunity the student is applying under).
 - Participation in designated area of opportunity
 - Maintain exemplary citizenship – no disciplinary actions
 - Maintain satisfactory attendance
 - Maintain a minimum GPA per area requirement
- Must maintain **Area Requirements** for the entire semester of each award. Failure to do so will result in the loss of the scholarship.
- Since this scholarship is funded by generous donors, scholarship recipients will be required to write a thank you letter that will be sent to the donors. The letter is due by November 15 and will be sent out by the Development Office.

Please note that this is a merit-based scholarship; it is not based on financial need and as long as funding is available.
