We have just celebrated Easter. Jesus died that we might have life and rose again so that we have an eternal hope for the future.

How did you celebrate Easter? Alone with Covid? Just another normal weekend? With family? Church?

Easter to me is special. Twelve years ago I had a doctor stand at the end of my hospital bed and say “you will be dead in 12 months” and in a second he was gone. Later he did come back and explain that I needed a liver transplant, and that without it I would certainly die. In the July of that year somebody died and I was given their liver. I cannot imagine how the family of the donor felt, or what they thought. I only know that someone died and as a result I could live. I am grateful beyond measure to that family. I can only imagine how much God the Father loves me to allow His son to die for me, so that I can live, be forgiven, be free and by Jesus' resurrection have a certainty for the future.

This week be determined to tell someone of what Jesus has done for you. Pray each day for those you know who do not know Jesus. Maybe it is your husband, wife, child, parent or close friend. You know what Jesus has done for you, tell them but be persistent in prayer for them. 7 days of intense prayer. 7 days of telling them of what Jesus has done.
