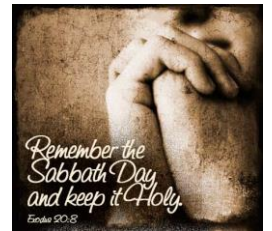


God's Gift of Grace:

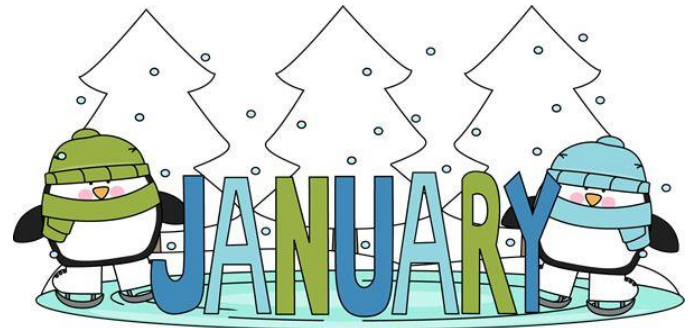
